INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXTENDED ABSTRACT

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Topics: main topic [, main topic 2]

Keywords: keyword 1, keyword 2 [, keyword 3] [, keyword 4] [, keyword 5]

EXTENDED ABSTRACT

An extended abstract of about **500 words** (two pages maximum), written in English, must be submitted in electronic format, using the Conference web site http://ecotrib2009.ing.unipi.it, before **November 30th**, **2008**. In case of problems and for any question, please, refer to the e-mail address ecotrib2009.ing.unipi.it. Since the acceptance of the paper for presentation in the Conference and the publication in the proceedings will be based on the extended abstract, it should clearly state the purpose, adopted methods, results and conclusions of the work to be described in the final paper.

Document formatting

Documents will be accepted only in ".pdf" format (portable document format) and must be smaller than 1 MByte. To avoid compatibility problems the authors should take care to include in the document (as a subset) all the fonts used and to ensure compatibility with the PDF version 1.5 (Acrobat 6) or earlier.

Use A4-size pages (210x297 mm) leaving a margin of 2 cm on all sides. Body text should be written with a 12 pt Times New Roman or similar font, in single line spacing and in a single column.

Use the present document as a sample. The document must start with the title of the work, followed by the names of the authors and their affiliation. The name of the reference author must be underlined.

Before the abstract, indicate the main topic(s) of the work (1 or 2) and a few (2 to 5) relevant keywords.

Equations, illustrations and references

A rather small number of equations is allowed in the extended abstract. When numbering equations, enclose numbers in parentheses and justify with the right-hand margin.

A few illustrations (pictures, graphs, tables) are also allowed. They should be positioned within the margins as close as possible to the relevant text. Illustrations must be original and captions must be clear and readable. Each figure or table must be identified with a progressive number. Figure number or table number should be typed at the beginning of the relative figure or table caption.




Fig. 1. Example of caption
